The applicant was transferred to Burdwan Police Line on June 3, 2011. On October 1, 2011 the applicant submitted application for his transfer from Burdwan to Birbhum on the ground of illness of his mother and daughter. Since the representation of the applicant was not considered the applicant approached the Tribunal by filing O.A. No. 1484 of 2011 on November 26, 2012. This Tribunal disposed of O.A. 1484 of 2011 by directing to the respondents to consider the representation of the applicant within a period of six weeks from the date of communication of the order. Accordingly, the respondent No. 4 considered the representation submitted by the applicant and passed an order by which he referred the representation of the applicant before Police Establishment Board which dealt with the transfer of the officers below the rank of Deputy</p>

The grievance of the applicant is that the said representation has not been considered by the respondent No. 4 till date.</p> <p>Having heard Learned Counsel representing both parties and on consideration of the fact that the representation submitted by the applicant on July 1, 2015 has not yet been considered by the respondent No. 4, we direct the respondent No. 4, Deputy Inspector General of Police (Administration), West Bengal to consider the representation of the applicant dated July 1, 2015 (Annexure 'K' to the original application) in accordance with law within a period of twelve weeks from the date of communication of the order and to communicate the result of the same to the applicant within a period of two weeks thereafter.</p> <p>With the above direction the original application is disposed of.</p> <p>Let a plain copy of the order be supplied to both parties.</p> <p>(S.K.
