level with immediate effect. Submission is as the applicants are working for more than thirteen years appropriate order may be passed staying the recruitment process.

Mr. A.L. Basu, learned advocate for the Public Service Commission, West Bengal submits that the applicants are not eligible to participate in the selection process since they are not Grade I officers which is one of the basic requirement for being promoted to the post of District Mass Education Extension Officer under the Recruitment Rules. Moreover, no order has been issued pursuant to the intimation dated 25<sup>th</sup> March 2008 which requested for passing a clear order and to the intimation dated 4<sup>th</sup> June, 2008 whereby request was made to execute the promotion from Grade II level to Grade I level.

Since the advertisement for recruitment was published in 2018 and this application has been filed belatedly on 8<sup>th</sup> April, 2019, and as the interview is going to be held on 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2019, no order may be passed.

Mr. Banerjee, adopting the submissions of Mr. Basu, submits that as the applicants are not Grade I officers, they have no locus standi to move this application and the application may be rejected.

Though it has been strenuously argued that the applicants have the requisite educational qualification, since appointment to the post concerned are to be filled up from Grade I officers and as the applicants are not Grade I officers, the prayers of the applicants cannot be Though it is submitted on behalf of the accepted. applicant that the notification dated 25th March, 2018 has come to light only recently, we are of the view that since the advertisement for recruitment was issued in 2018 it cannot be the ground for filing this application belatedly on 8<sup>th</sup> April, 2019 for staying the selection process which is to be held on 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2019. The letter dated 25th March, 2008, addressed by the Director of Mass Education to the Principal Secretary, relied on by the applicant, cannot come to the aid of the applicant as subsequently no order was issued. SCN. Hence, no order is passed on this application. The application is dismissed. Urgent photostat certified copy of this order be furnished to the parties.
