	In this application, the applicant, - who was	
	appointed as Upper Division Clerk and thereafter by	
	virtue of order dated 16 th June, 2004, was appointed on	
	promotion to officiate temporarily to the post of "Head	
	Clerk" under the Executive Engineer, Cooch Behar	
	Division, Public Health Engineering Directorate and who	
	was thereafter transferred from Cooch Behar to	
	Murshidabad by order dated 6 th January, 2017, - has	
	prayed for a direction upon the respondents to allow him	
	to resume his duty at Murshidabad Circle, P.H.E.

	Directorate after considering his representations dated 30 th	
	January, 2019 and 12 th February, 2019. Prayer has also	
	been made to calculate and consider the commuted leave	
	on medical ground and earned leave on medical ground	
	from 18 th January, 2017 to 1 st December, 2017 (affixing	
	holiday on 2 nd December, 2017 and 3 rd December, 2017)	
	and earned leave from 26 th March, 2018 to 11 th May, 2018	
	(Pre-affixing holiday on 24 th March, 2018 and 25 th March,	
	2018, affixing holiday on 12 th May, 2018 to 14 th May,	
	2018) due to death of his mother and father as due and	
	admissible and for a direction to the Executive Engineer,	
	Cooch Behar, P.H.E. Department to sanction the said	
	leave which may be accounted towards increment,	
	seniority, qualifying service and for pensionary and other	
	benefits.	
	It appears from records that challenging the order	
	of transfer the applicant had moved the Tribunal in O.A.	
	65 of 2017 which was dismissed on 27 th January, 2017.	
	Aggrieved, the applicant filed a writ petition, being	
	W.P.S.T. No. 37 of 2017, which was dismissed by passing	
	an order on 23 rd May, 2017 the relevant portion of which	
	is as under:

	interference by the Court. The order of	
	transfer records the same is being	
	effected in the interest of public and it	
	appears to be a chain transfer. The	
	violations, which the petitioner	
	complained of, in our view, do not give	
	rise to any enforceable legal right to	
	the petitioner. We do not find any	
	reason to interfere with the order of the	
	Tribunal.	
	The writ petition is, thus,	
	dismissed."	
	Aggrieved still, the applicant filed a Special	
	Leave Petition, being Petition (s) for Special Leave to	
	Appeal (C) No(s). 30362 / 2017, before the Supreme	
	Court of India, which was dismissed by an order passed	
	on 17 th November, 2017, the relevant portion of which is	
	as under:	
	"We do not find any reason to	
	entertain the Special Leave Petition, which is,	
	accordingly, dismissed.	
	However, taking note of the	
	submission that the son of the petitioner is	
	studying in Class X and he has to appear in	
	Board Examinations in April, 2018, the

	It is pertinent to mention that the applicant	
	thereafter had filed an application, being CAN 2952 of	
	2018 in W.P.S.T. 37 of 2017 for modification of the order	
	dated 23 rd May, 2017 which was dismissed by an order	
	dated 10 th December, 2018 by passing an order the	
	relevant portion of which is as under:	
	"CAN 2952 of 2018 is an	
	application for modification of an	
	order dated May 23, 2017 passed by a	
	coordinate Bench of this Court.	
	The coordinate Bench	
	dismissed the writ petition filed by the	
	applicant / petitioner (hereafter the	
	applicant), wherein the order of the	
	West Bengal Administrative Tribunal	
	dated January 27, 2017 dismissing the	
	original application of the applicant	
	was under challenge. In such original	
	application an order transferring the	
	applicant from Cooch Behar to	
	Murshidabad had been challenged.

	the view that as and when for	
	administrative reason or in public	
	interest a transfer is ordered and it is	
	subjected to challenge scope of	
	interference by the writ court is limited	
	and since the applicant had been	
	transferred in the interest of public	
	service, no enforceable legal right	
	accrued in his favour. By filing this	
	application, the applicant has sought to	
	urge before this Court that despite	
	joining the transferred post at	
	Murshidabad, he has neither been	
	allotted any job nor paid his salary.	
	If indeed that be so, it affords	
	a fresh cause of action to the applicant	
	to move the tribunal. No case for	
	modification of the order dated May	
	23, 2017 has been set up.	
	The application stands	
	dismissed, with liberty as aforesaid."	
	It is submitted by Mr. Dalapati that though on	
	19 th March, 2018 the applicant went to join the office at	
	Murshidabad, as evident from page 41 of the application,	
	according to him though he had joined, however, till date	
	no duties have been allotted. Hence, it is submitted that

appropriate order may be passed directing the respondents to record his date of joining being 19th March, 2018 and to allot him duties and to pay salary.

Mr. Banerjee submits that it is evident from the petition that though the applicant was released from Cooch Behar on 26th January, 2017, however, the applicant on 4th Decmeber, 2017 had submitted a letter regarding his joining at Cooch Behar as evident from page 38 of the application. Therefore, the applicant could not have joined at Murshidabad and has not joined and the applicant has landed in this situation for a fault of his own. Submission is for his unauthorised absence, departmental proceeding has been initiated against the applicant to which Mr. Dalpati submits that he is yet to receive any order regarding such proceeding.

Heard Mr. Dalpati and Mr. Banerjee. Keeping in mind the orders passed by the Tribunal, the High Court and the Supreme Court and since we find that by memo dated 21st May, 2018 the Executive Engineer, Cooch Behar, PHE Directorate has sent the Last Pay Certificate the service book and of the applicant the Superintending Engineer, Murshidabad Circle, P.H.E. Directorate, which means he has been released by the Cooch Behar Division and as we find that the applicant had joined Murshidabad on 19th March, 2018, this
