The applicant has prayed for direction upon the respondents to give compassionate appointment to the applicant after setting aside the order communicated to the applicant by the respondent No. 3 on August 13, 2013.</p> <p>The contention of the applicant is that his father died in harness while he was working as government employee. The applicant submitted application for compassionate appointment after almost nine years of death of his father. On perusal of impugned letter dated August 18, 2013 issued by the respondent No. 3, we find that the prayer of the applicant was rejected on the ground that there was no need of immediate financial assistance to the members of the deceased employee as the wife of the deceased employee was also a government employee at the time of death of the concerned employee. We do not find any illegality in rejecting prayer of the applicant for compassionate appoint as there was no acute financial</p>
