	as to disburse the arrear salaries from	
	the month of February, 2019 onwards

	It appears that by notification dated 28 th January,	
	2019 the applicant, the Additional District Magistrate of	
	Purba Burdwan was transferred to Uttar Dinajpur as	
	Additional District Magistrate and was subsequently	
	released on 31st January, 2019. As the applicant did not	
	join, the O.S.D & Ex-Officio Joint Secretary to the	
	Government of West Bengal, the respondent no.2, by	
	intimation dated 22 nd February, 2019, requested him to	
	join failing which it was intimated that appropriate	
	departmental action would be initiated against him.	
	Thereafter the applicant had filed a representation dated	
	28 th February, 2019 requesting for cancellation of the	
	posting as he was facing physical and mental problems.	
	By intimation dated 19 th March, 2019 the applicant was	
	intimated that a Medical Board would be constituted for

examination of the applicant and he should be present failing which departmental action would be taken against him. Subsequently, by intimation dated 26th April, 2019 the applicant was directed to appear before the Central Medical Board, Medical College & Hospital, Kolkata on 30th April, 2019 which the applicant had complied with. The applicant was found medically stable and fit to resume duties as evident from the memo dated 19th June, 2019. In the meantime on 10th June, 2019 the applicant made a prayer to join. It is submitted by Mr. G.P. Banerjee, learned advocate for the applicant that the 10th July, 2019 had filed a fresh applicant on representation before the Principal Secretary, Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department & e-Governance, (WBCS Cell), Government of West Bengal, the respondent No.1, making a request to allow him to join. Submission is since the post of Additional District Magistrate, Uttar Dinajpur has been filled up the respondent authorities may be directed to take a decision on the representation dated 10th July, 2019 about his place of posting.

Mr. S. Ghosh, learned advocate appearing on behalf of the respondents submits, if directed, the respondent authorities will take decision in accordance with law.
