We grant liberty to the respondents to file affidavit-inopposition within six weeks; reply thereto, if any, may be filed by two weeks thereafter. The petitioners shall have the liberty of mentioning the original application for final hearing before the tribunal immediately after expiry of the time limit for exchange of if affidavits above or as respondents do not file their affidavitin-opposition, immediately after expiry of the time limit fixed therefor. Since the employee had expired about 38 years back, we request the tribunal to give the original application some precedence for its early disposal, subject to its convenience. It is made clear, we have not expressed any opinion on the merits of the petitioners' claim as reflected in
