	It appears that the applicant had participated in	
	the 2010 selection process for the post of Fire Engine	
	Operator-cum-Driver – FEOD. It appears that he had also	
	applied for the post of FEOD in the 2014 selection	
	process. It also appears that there was selection process	
	for the post of Fire Operator in the year, 2018. It appears	
	from the application that being aggrieved by the 2010	
	selection process, the applicant had filed a representation	
	before the Principal Secretary, West Bengal Fire and	
	Emergency Services, Kolkata, the respondent no. 1, being	
	Annexure "A6" to the application.	
	Mr. S. Roy Chowdhury, learned advocate for	
	the applicant submits that as the applicant had performed	
	well in the 2010 selection process he should be treated at	
	par with other 140 selected candidates who have been	
	given appointment and be appointed.

	Fire Operator and not for FEOD.	
	We find that the grounds do not disclose	
	whether the challenge has been made for selection process	
	of 2010 or 2014 or 2018. Moreover, as it appears that the	
	applicant has challenged the selection process of 2010, we	
	are of the view that the application is barred by limitation	
	prescribed under Section 21 of the Administrative	
SCN	Tribunals Act, 1985. Therefore, the application is	
	dismissed.
