It appears that on 2nd May, 2018, the applicant had filed an application under the Right to Information Act, 2005 before the Public Information Officer (PIO), West Bengal Public Service Commission wherein the applicant had sought for the following information :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> “1. Despite service of notice, none appears on behalf of the West Bengal Public Service Commission.</p> <p>Since the queries made in the application dated 2nd May, 2018 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 are not in consonance with the prayer made in this application, this application is disposed of by granting liberty to the applicant to file appropriate application under the Right to Information Act, 2005 before the West Bengal Public Service Commission in accordance with the law.</p> <p>(P.
