	There is no dispute that the applicant, the widow	
	of Buchan Chandra Mahato, who had expired while in	
	harness, is entitled to Rs. 50,695/ However, it is evident	
	from memo dated 20 <sup>th</sup> December, 2000, issued by the	
	Block Development Officer, Manbazar-I Development	
	Block, Purulia, respondent no.3, appearing at page 14 of	
	the original application, that the cheque could not be	
	delivered to her as it could not be revalidated. The	
	applicant prays for revalidation of the said cheque
