Since we find that the Medical Board has declared the applicant to be fit for further service, considering such fact, the Sub-Divisional Land & Land Reforms officer, Durgapur City Centre, Durgapur, District Paschim Burdwan, respondent no.3 shall allow the applicant to join his duties within seven days from the date of filing a formal application along with copy of this order. So far as payment of arrear salary is concerned, the same shall be dealt with and disposed of by the said respondent no.3 by passing a reasoned order to be communicated to the parties within eight weeks from the date of joining after giving an opportunity for hearing to the applicant and after verifying the records. If it is found that the applicant is entitled to arrear salary it will be granted on compliance of formalities, if any. We make it clear that we have not gone into the issue SCN. of the disciplinary proceedings which is a separate matter altogether. The original application is disposed of. (S.K. Das) (Soumitra Pal)
