In this application, the applicant, a Group 'D' staff in the Department of Civil Defence, Government of West Bengal has prayed for a direction upon the respondents to withdraw the order dated 20<sup>th</sup> April, 2015, issued by the A.O. & E.O. Joint Secretary, Government of West Bengal, Department of higher Education, Science & Technology and Biotechnology, N.C.C. Branch. Bikash Bhavan, Kolkata, the respondent No. 2 under which he was placed under suspension with effect from 14<sup>th</sup> January, 2015 as he was involved in a criminal case being Tarakeswar P.S. Case No. 17 / 15 dated 14th January, 2015 U/s 498A / 306 / 304B IPC instituted against the applicant and his mother. The proceedings continued. It appears from the application that ultimately by judgement dated 17th November, 2016 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge Chandernagore, the applicant has been acquitted as they have been found not guilty for the commission of the offence U/s 498A / 306 / 304B IPC and they were acquitted u/s 232 Cr. P.C. and they were discharged from their respective bail bonds. It is submitted by Mr. Majumder, as no disciplinary proceedings have been initiated and the petitioners have been acquitted of all the charges, appropriate direction may be given to the respondents to allow him to join

Despite service of notice none appears on behalf of the respondents.

Having heard Mr. Majumder, appearing on behalf of the applicant and considering the fact that the applicant has been acquitted of the charges framed under the Indian Penal Code by the judgement dated 17<sup>th</sup> November, 2016 by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Chandernagore, the Additional Chief Secretary, Government of West Bengal, Department of Higher Education, Science & Technology Biotechnology, Kolkata, respondent no.1 is directed to withdraw the order of suspension dated 20<sup>th</sup> April, 2015 within one week from the date of presentation of a copy of the certified copy of this order and will allow the applicant to join the concerned post within a week thereafter.

Since the applicant has been acquitted of all the charges, in our view, in view of the settled proposition of law, he is entitled to full salary and payment thereof for the period during which he was kept under suspension. Therefore, if an application is filed by the applicant for payment of full salary during the period of suspension, the Additional Chief
