Bhattacharjee, Departmental Representative.</p> <p>Liberty is given to the applicant to implead Additional District Magistrate, in-charge of Refugee, Relief and Rehabilitation, Nadia as respondent no. 6 by way of amendment of Cause Title of the original application in course of this day.</p> <p>The applicant has prayed for direction upon the respondents to grant her family pension after the death of her mother. The contention of the applicant is that the applicant submitted representation in this regard before the respondent nos. 4 and 2, but the said representation has not been considered by the concerned respondent till date. Mr. Bhattacharjee, the Departmental Representative of the state respondents, contends that the representation of the applicant for grant of family pension can be considered by the Additional District Magistrate, in-charge of Refugee, Relief and Rehabilitation of the district of Nadia, but no representation is submitted before the said respondent no. 6 by the applicant till date.</p> <p>Under the above circumstances, the applicant is at liberty to submit representation before the respondent no. 6 in</p>	

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connection with grant of family pension within a period of four (4) weeks from this date. If such representation is submitted by the applicant, the said respondent no. 6 will consider the said representation after giving the applicant an opportunity of hearing and decide in accordance with law about entitlement of the applicant to get family pension within a period of twelve (12) weeks from the date of submission of the representation by the applicant and take necessary follow up action in this regard within a period of four (4) weeks thereafter.

With the above direction, the original application is **disposed of.**
