	The applicant retired on February 28, 2013 as	
	Head Clerk from the office of Milk Commissioner,	
	Government of West Bengal. The departmental	
	proceeding was initiated against the applicant while he	
	was in service and the punishment was imposed on the	
	applicant by the Disciplinary Authority on December	
	30, 2011. The said order of punishment was	
	challenged by the applicant before this Tribunal by	
	filing OA-590 of 2014 which was disposed of on August	
	10, 2016. The Tribunal directed the Disciplinary	
	Authority of the applicant to reconsider quantum of	
	punishment imposed on the applicant within stipulated	
	period of time after setting aside the punishment imposed on the applicant. Accordingly, the Disciplinary	
	Authority imposed punishment afresh after setting	
	aside the previous punishment imposed on the	
	applicant as directed by the Tribunal on August 10,	
	2016 in connection with OA-590 of 2014. The fixation	
	of pay of the applicant was revised by the respondent	
	no. 2 by passing a reasoned order on December 7,	
	2016. The grievance of the applicant is that his

pension and other retirement benefits have not been revised in accordance with the revision of pay of the applicant.

Learned Counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has received pension and other retirement benefits after imposition of initial punishment on him but the said pension and other retirement benefits have not been revised in accordance with the revision of pay done by the respondent no. 2 on December 7, 2016.

We are informed that the respondent no. 3 is the Pension Sanctioning Authority of the applicant. Having heard Learned Counsel representing the applicant, Learned Counsel representing the state respondents and the authorized representative of AG (A&E), West Bengal, we are of the view that the respondent no. 3 is duty bound to pass an order in connection with revised pension, arrears of gratuity, if any, and arrears of leave encashment, if any within stipulated period of time. Accordingly, the respondent no. 3 is directed to take necessary steps for fixation of revised pension of the applicant, arrears of gratuity and arrears of leave encashment in accordance with revision of pay done by the respondent no. 2 on December 7, 2016 within a period of 12 (twelve) weeks from the date of communication of the order. The respondent no. 3 is further directed to send a copy of this order along with necessary documents to AG (A&E), West Bengal within
