Mr. Amjad Ali, Learned Senior Counsel representing the applicant has produced certified copy of the judgment passed by the Hon'ble High Court in WPST No. 45 of 2017, which is kept on record. It appears from the said certified copy that one Swapan Kumar Dey is impleaded as respondent No. 2A in the writ application filed before the Hon'ble High Court. Mr. Ali submits that the applicant has no objection for impleading the added respondent in the original application by way of</p>

amendment of Cause Title of the said application. Mr. Basu, Learned Counsel representing the state respondents, submits that the added respondent should file formal application for impleading as respondent in the original application and copy of the same must be served on the state respondents, so that the state respondents may get the opportunity to make appropriate submission before the Bench.

Having heard Learned Counsel representing all the parties and on consideration of the fact that Mr. Swapan Kumar Dey was impleaded as respondent No. 2A in the writ application filed by the applicant before the Hon'ble High Court, we are of the view that Mr. Swapan Kumar Dey need to be impleaded as added respondent in the original application. However, the particulars of Mr. Swapan Kumar Dey need to be supplied before the Tribunal by filing one formal application and Mr. Samim who is inclined to represent the said respondent must file the Vakalatnama before the Tribunal. Accordingly, liberty is given for filing formal application along with Vakalatnama for impleading Mr. Swapan Kumar Dey as added respondent in the original application by tomorrow.

Before commencement of hearing, Mr. Basu, Learned Counsel submits on instruction from his client that one Review Application is filed by the state respondents before the Hon'ble High Court for extension of the time schedule fixed by the
