Having heard Learned Counsel for the applicant and the Departmental Representative of the state respondents and on consideration of the materials on record, we find that the applicant received Rs.2000/- as monthly remuneration for discharging duty as part time contractual employee in the establishment of the respondent no. 5. Accordingly, the applicant is not entitled to get remuneration in terms of Memorandum No. 9008-F(P) dated September 16, 2011 and subsequent Memorandum dated May 20, 2013 and Memorandum dated February 25, 2016 issued by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal.
