It is submitted on behalf of the applicant that the matter should be sent to an expert other than the expert who had conducted the examination on behalf of the Board. Heard learned advocates for the parties. Admittedly the last OBC-B successful candidate had SCN. secured 48.035 marks and the applicant, an OBC-B candidate had scored 47.66 marks. In our view, since the recruitment body consisting of experts have evaluated the answer scripts and Courts do not possess that expertise, it should be slow in directing fresh evaluation of answer scripts.
