West Bengal forwarded the name of the respondent no. 6 to the Assistant Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Irrigation & Waterways, for compassionate appointment. The grievance of the present applicant is that his application compassionate appointment submitted on April 4, 2007 has not yet been considered by the respondents. Since there are two applicants for compassionate appointment, it is the duty of the respondents to decide who is eligible for compassionate appointment on consideration of their respective claims and the income of the family of the deceased employee as per Notification issued by the Labour Department, Government of West Bengal, which was in force at the time of death of the concerned employee.

In view of our above findings, we direct the respondent no. 2, Director of Personnel & Ex-Officio Chief Engineer, Department of Irrigation & Waterways, Government of West Bengal to consider the application of both the applicant and the respondent no. 6 in accordance with law and take a decision after giving both the applicant and the respondent no. 6 an opportunity of hearing within a period of **16** (sixteen) weeks from the date of communication of the order and to communicate the result of the same to the applicant and the respondent no. 6 within a period of **2** (two) weeks thereafter. The applicant and the respondent no. 6 are directed to furnish information/document, if
