	The applicant has prayed for direction upon the	
	respondents to release family pension, gratuity and	
	leave encashment in connection with service of the	
	father of the applicant.	
	One Sheopujan Rout joined as Operator Grade-III	
	in the establishment of Mechanical Sub-Division No. IV	
	under Burdwan Mechanical Division, Department of	
	PW (Roads) on November 18, 1965. He was released	
	from the office of Mechanical Sub-Division No. IV,	
	Burdwan Mechanical Division of PW (Roads) on July 1,	
	1981 for joining his new assignment at Kharagpur	
	Mechanical Sub-Division under Midnapore Mechanical	
	Division of PW (Roads). It appears from the reply	
	submitted on behalf of the state respondents that he	
	never joined in his new assignment after his release	
	from the office of Mechanical Sub-Division No. IV on	
	July 1, 1981. He was absent from office on the ground	
	of illness for prolonged period of time and ultimately he	
	died on March 24, 1996, though the applicant has	
	claimed the date of superannuation of Sheopujan Rout

Lakhrajo Devi died on November 4, 1996. Presently, the applicant and respondent nos. 6 and 7 - being two sons and one married daughter have claimed to be the legal heirs of the deceased Sheopujan Rout. The grievance of the applicant is that pension, gratuity, leave encashment, GPF amount and family pension have not been released in favour of the legal heirs of the deceased Sheopujan Rout, in spite of submission of repeated representations by the applicant before the respondent no. 4.

We have heard the applicant in person. We have also heard the Learned Counsel representing the state On consideration of the materials on respondents. record, we find that Sheopujan Rout worked in the office of Mechanical Sub-Division No. IV under Burdwan Mechanical Division of PW (Roads) from November 18, 1965 to July 1, 1981. His long absence from duty during the period from July 2, 1981 till the date of his death on March 24, 1996 cannot be regularised by grant of any leave as per provisions of West Bengal Service Rules, Part-I. Accordingly, we are of the view that the service of Sheopujan Rout has come to an end w.e.f. July 1, 1981. Admittedly, service benefits have not been given either to Sheopujan Rout or his legal heirs as reflected from the reply submitted by the state respondents. Since the applicant and the respondent nos. 6 and 7 claim to be the legal heirs of Sheopujan Rout and since service benefits have not

been given to Sheopujan Rout for rendering service during the period of November 18, 1965 to July 1, 1981, we are inclined to give direction to the respondent no. 4 to decide the entitlement of Sheopujan Rout about service benefits like pension, gratuity, amount of GPF and amount of leave encashment and to pass a reasoned order after giving the applicant an opportunity of hearing.

The respondent no. 4, Executive Engineer, Mechanical Division, PWD (Roads), Purta Bhavan, 4th Floor, Dist – Purba Bardhaman is directed to decide entitlement of Sheopujan Rout to receive pension, gratuity, leave encashment and amount of GPF, if any, after giving the applicant and other legal heirs an opportunity of hearing and to pass a reasoned order within a period of 16 (sixteen) weeks from the date of communication of this order and to intimate the result of the same to the applicant and to take necessary follow up action for release of all retiral dues to the legal heirs of Sheopujan Rout, if any, within a period of 2 (two) weeks thereafter.

With the above direction, the original application is **disposed of.**

Let a plain copy of this order be supplied to both parties.
