	The applicant has filed the original application	
	under section 19 of the Administrative Tribunals Act,	
	1985 challenging the order communicated under letter	
	dated August 7, 2013 issued by the respondent no. 2	
	(Annexure-L to the original application) and praying for	
	direction upon the respondents to give appointment to	
	the applicant on compassionate ground.	
	The contention of the applicant is that one	
	Manaranjan Chakraborty died on December 12, 2004	
	while he was working as Gardener in the office of	
	District Officer, Department of Food Processing	
	Industries and Horticulture, Uttar Dinajpur. The said	
	Manaranjan Chakraborty adopted the applicant as his	
	son on the basis of the registered Deed of Adoption	
	dated September 12, 1989. The application filed by the	
	applicant for compassionate appointment as adopted	
	son of the deceased employee was rejected on the basis	
	of opinion of Learned Legal Remembrancer which was	
	communicated under the impugned letter dated August	
	7, 2013. It appears from the said letter that Shibesh	
	Chandra Chakraborty, the biological father of the	
	applicant did not obtain consent of his wife for giving

adoption of the applicant by executing registered Deed of Adoption. The respondent no. 2 communicated the inability of the department to consider the case of the applicant for compassionate appointment as the wife of Shibesh Chandra Chakraborty did not give her consent for adoption of her son i.e. the applicant.

By referring to the Affidavit sworn by one Laxmi Chakraborty, wife of Late Shibesh Chandra Chakraborty (Annexure-O to the original application), Mr. Banerjee, Learned Counsel for the applicant submits that the wife of Shibesh Chandra Chakraborty has subsequently conveyed her consent with regard to adoption of the applicant, but the said Affidavit has not been considered by the authority concerned in rejecting the prayer of the applicant for compassionate appointment. Since the grievance of the applicant is that the Affidavit sworn by the biological mother of the applicant on November 7, 2013 has not been considered by the authority concerned, we are of the view that the said Affidavit may be considered by the authority concerned to decide the case of the applicant afresh.

In view of our above findings, the order of the department communicated under letter dated August 7, 2013 (Annexure-L to the original application) is set aside. The respondent no. 1, Secretary, Department of Food Processing Industries & Horticulture, Government

of West Bengal is directed to reconsider the case of the applicant for compassionate appointment on the basis of the materials already available on record and on the basis of the Affidavit dated November 7, 2013 sworn by Laxmi Chakraborty (Annexure-O to the original application) in accordance with law within a period of 12 (twelve) weeks from the date of communication of this order and communicate the result of the same to the applicant within a period of 2 (two) weeks thereafter.
