	The applicant has prayed for direction upon the	
	respondents to give interest to the applicant on gratuity	
	and pension for the delay in making payment of	
	gratuity and pension.	
	It appears from the materials on record that the	
	applicant retired from the post of Revenue Officer on	
	July 31, 2009. The applicant was attached to the office	
	of respondent no. 7 at the time of retirement. The	
	applicant had to approach the Tribunal for inordinate	
	delay in making payment of pension and retirement	
	benefits by filing OA-389 of 2013. On August 29, 2013,	
	this Tribunal disposed of OA-389 of 2013 by giving	
	direction to the Principal Secretary, Land & Land	
	Reforms Department, Government of West Bengal to	
	release provisional pension and retirement benefits in	
	favour of the applicant. It is contended on behalf of the	
	applicant that the applicant has already received	
	pension, retiring gratuity, commuted value of pension	
	and other retirement benefits. The grievance of the	
	applicant is that there was delay of almost 5 (five) years	
	in giving gratuity and commuted value of pension, but	
	no interest is paid on the amount of gratuity and the

amount of commuted value of pension to the applicant. There was nothing on record to indicate that the delay in making payment of gratuity and other retirement benefits can be attributed to the conduct of the applicant.

It appears from the certificate regarding payment of retiring gratuity and commuted value of pension to the applicant (which was issued by the respondent no. 7 on May 5, 2014) that the applicant was given retiring gratuity of Rs.3,72,075/- vide Token No. 986 dated April 28, 2014 issued by the Treasury Officer, Berhampore-I and Rs.3,82,299/- as commuted value of pension vide Token No. 987 dated April 28, 2014 issued by the Treasury Officer, Berhampore-I. The applicant must have received the said amount of money in the month of May, 2014. By virtue of Memo. No. 9112-F dated September 24, 1979 issued by the Finance Department (Audit Branch), Government of West Bengal read with Memo. No. 2196-F (Pen) dated December 9, 1991 addressed to the Deputy Accountant General (Pension), AG, West Bengal by the Deputy Secretary, Finance Department (Audit Branch), Government of West Bengal, any Government employee is entitled to get interest @ 5% per annum on the amount of gratuity for delay beyond the period of 3 (three) months after the gratuity becomes due till the end of the month preceding the month in which payment is actually made, if the delay cannot be

	attributed to any fault on the part of the Government	
	employee. In view of the above Government Order, the	
	applicant is entitled to interest @ 5% per annum on the	
	amount of retiring gratuity of Rs.3,72,075/- for the	
	period from November 1, 2009 to April 30, 2014. On	
	the same analogy, the applicant is also entitled to get	
	interest @ 5% per annum on the amount of commuted	
	value of pension of Rs.3,82,299/- for the period from	
	November 1, 2009 to April 30, 2014.	
	The respondent no. 7 is directed to make	
	payment of interest on the amount of retiring gratuity	
	and commuted value of pension as observed by us to	
	the applicant within a period of 12 (twelve) weeks from	
	the date of communication of the order.	
	With the above direction, the original application	
	is disposed of .	
	Let a plain copy of this order be supplied to both	
	parties.
