Rep.</p> <p>The grievance of the applicant in the present application is that the respondent no. 7, the Principal, Krishnanagar Government College has not disbursed the family pension in favour of the applicant. The applicant happens to be mother of one Anupam Maity who died on October 30, 2008 while he was working as Assistant Professor of Krishnanagar Government College in the district of Nadia. The mother being the only dependent of the deceased Anupam Maity submitted application for family pension before the respondent no. 7 who forwarded the case of the applicant to the Principal Accountant General (A&E), Government of West Bengal.</p> <p>Mr. Mitra, the authorised representative of the respondent no. 3 has produced a copy of letter dated September 24, 2015, whereby Senior Accounts Officer of the respondent no. 3 has sent one letter to the respondent no. 7 calling upon him to issue a certificate about dependency of the applicant and forward the same to the office of the Principal Accountant General</p>

(A&E), Government of West Bengal. A copy of the said letter is handed over to Learned Counsel for the applicant by Mr. Mitra in the Tribunal today itself. Unfortunately, the respondent no. 7 has not yet issued the necessary certificate and forwarded the same to the respondent no. 3 for processing the case of the applicant for the purpose of family pension.

Under the above circumstances, we direct the respondent no. 7 to issue necessary certificate as desired under letter dated September 24, 2015 by the Senior Accounts Officer of the respondent no. 3 after giving the applicant an opportunity of hearing and by observing necessary formalities within a period of 8 (eight) weeks from the date of communication of the order. The respondent no. 3 is directed to issue the order of family pension in favour of the applicant within a period of 8 (eight) weeks from the date of receiving necessary certificate from the respondent no. 7.

The applicant is directed to communicate this order to the respondent no. 7 by speed post within a period of 2 (two) weeks from the date of this order.

With the above directions, the original application is disposed of.
