enhanced to Rs.3,000/- per month in terms of Memorandum No. 7284-F(P<sub>2</sub>)/FA/O/2M-1 dated November 27, 2017 issued by Finance (Audit) Department, Government of West Bengal. He further submits that the applicants have been drawing remuneration @ Rs.3,000/- per month.

Under the above circumstances, we direct the respondent no. 3, District Land & Land Reforms Officer, Paschim Medinipur to consider the entitlement of the applicants to get financial benefits in terms of Memorandum No. 11794-F(P) dated December 22, 2010, 9008-F(P) dated September 16, 2011 and 4011-F(P) dated May 20, 2013 issued by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal within a period of 12 (twelve) weeks from the date of communication of the order and to intimate the result of the same to the applicants within a period of 2 (two) weeks thereafter.

With the above direction, the original application stands **disposed of.**
