	The applicant has prayed for direction upon the	
	respondents to release family pension, arrears of pension	
	of her deceased husband and retirement benefits of her	
	deceased husband with interest.	
	The contention of the applicant is that her husband	
	Dr. Yusuf Ali was appointed as Dentral Surgeon by the	
	Department of Health & Family Welfare, Government of	
	West Bengal on August 9, 1973. The further contention	
	of the applicant is that Dr. Yusuf Ali retired from service	
	on September 30, 2001 as Dental Surgeon, Bagda Rural	
	Health Centre in the district of North 24-Parganas. It is	
	contented on behalf of the applicant that Dr. Yusuf Ali	
	died on April 22, 2010 without receiving any pension and	
	without receiving retirement benefits as Government	
	employee. He died leaving behind the applicant as his	
	widow, one daughter and three sons as legal heirs. The	
	applicant submitted application before the respondent no.	
	2, Director of Health Services, Government of West Bengal	
	on August 8, 2012 praying for release of family pension,	
	arrears of pension and other retirement benefits of her	
	husband, but the said respondent has not yet considered	
	the application of the applicant. It appears from letter

dated October 1, 2012 issued by the Director of Health Services, Government of West Bengal that the order has not been issued by the concerned department for release of retirement benefits of the deceased husband of the applicant and for grant of family pension in favour of the applicant.

Having heard Learned Counsel representing the applicant and the authorized representative of AG (A&E), West Bengal, we direct the respondent no. 3, Chief Medical Officer of Health, North 24-Parganas to consider entitlement of the applicant to get family pension, arrears of pension and retirement benefits of her deceased husband and pass a reasoned order after giving the applicant an opportunity of hearing, if necessary, within a period of 12 (twelve) weeks from the date of communication of the order and to communicate the result of the same to the applicant within a period of 2 (two) weeks thereafter.

The applicant is directed to serve a copy of this order along with copy of application and annexures thereto on the Chief Medical Officer of Health, North 24-Parganas by Speed Post within a period of 2 (two) weeks from this date.

With the above direction, the original application is disposed of.

Let a plain copy of this order be supplied to both parties.
