	The applicant was appointed in the post of	
	Master (English), at Victoria Boys' School, Kurseong	
	temporarily for a period of two years with effect from	
	March 16, 1995 as reflected from the notification dated	
	December 12, 1995 issued by the Joint Secretary to the	
	Government of West Bengal, Department of School	
	Education. The applicant has been transferred from his	
	present assignment of Headmaster-in-Charge, Victoria	
	Boys' School, Kurseong to the post of Teacher-in-Charge,	
	Ranibandh Government Model High School, Bankura by	
	order dated November 24, 2016 issued by the Joint	
	Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department	
	of School Education. The contention of the applicant is	
	that he cannot be transferred from the post of Headmaster-	
	in-Charge of Victoria Boys' School as he does not belong	
	to transferrable service. The applicant has prayed for	
	quashing of the transfer order dated November 24, 2016	
	(Annexure "A" to the original application).

On perusal of the notification dated December 12, 1995 issued by the Joint Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of School Education we find that the applicant was appointed on probation as a member of West Bengal General Service (Education) and he was posted temporarily as Master (English) at Victoria Boys' School, Kurseong. Learned Counsel for the applicant has made two fold submissions: first, the applicant has been transferred to a lower post and secondly, the applicant belongs to West Bengal Senior Education Service. On consideration of the letter of appointment, we find that the applicant belongs to West Bengal General Service (Education) and as such, we do not accept submission made on behalf of the applicant. With regard to the submission of Learned Counsel that the applicant has been transferred to the lower post, he has failed to place on record that the pay-scale drawn by the applicant as Headmaster-in-Charge of Victoria Boys' School is higher than the pay-scale of Teacher-in-Charge of Ranibandh Government Model High School, Bankura and as such, we do not find any merit in the submission made on behalf of the applicant. What we find from the materials on record is that the applicant belongs to West Bengal General Service (Education) and his service condition will be governed by the provisions of West Bengal Service Rules Part 1. It is well settled that the transfer is a

	condition of service to which the applicant belongs,	
	though the order of transfer cannot be made in a malafide	
	way or by way of punishment or in violation of provisions

	is either punitive in nature or malafide or in violation of	
	any provision of the statute. Accordingly, we do not find	
	any illegality in the order of transfer which is justified	
	under the law. The original application is, thus,	
	dismissed.
