the applicant has already been concluded, and if concluded, what final order has been passed in the said disciplinary proceeding.

- (ii) what final order has already been passed on prayer of the applicant to retire voluntarily from service and if no final decision has yet been taken, the reasons for not taking final decision on prayer of voluntary retirement of the applicant.
- (iii) whether the applicant was permitted to retire from service on attaining age of superannuation by passing specific order, and if no such order has been issued, the reasons for not passing such an order when the applicant has already attained the age of superannuation.

The above information supported by relevant documents must be filed by the respondent No. 1 within a period of 8 (eight) weeks from the date of passing this order. The Advocate on record for the state respondents will communicate this order to the respondent no. 1 positively within a period of one (01) week from this date.

Since the applicant has already crossed the retirement age and since the applicant has not received the amount of money deposited by her in the GPF account, in spite of submission of application by the applicant, we direct the
