	respondents that all the vacancies of Junior Constables in	
	West Bengal Police have been filled up on the basis of	
	result of the Examination held in the year 2011, except	
	381 posts (male and female) belonging to OBC- A	
	Category. It also appears from reply submitted by the	
	State respondents that all the applicants obtained less	
	marks than the marks obtained by the last selected	
	candidates in their respective categories.	
	Mr. D.N. Ray, Learned Counsel representing the	
	applicants submits that the State respondents did not	
	disclose the number of vacancies available in OBC -A	
	Category in the advertisement and as such, the State	
	respondents cannot take the plea that 381 posts belonging	
	to OBC -A Category have not been filled up for non-	
	availability of suitable candidates. We do not find any	
	merit in this submission made on behalf of the applicants,	
	as the advertisement clearly indicates that the posts will be	
	reserved for OBC Category. While the posts have been	
	reserved for OBC Category, the percentage of reservation	
	for OBC -A Category and OBC -B Category will be	
	decided on the basis of the statute or statutory Rules in
