November 29, 2017 and the applicant has been superseded. The further contention of the applicant is that the representation submitted by the applicant in connection with his promotion has not been considered by the concerned state respondents till date.</p> <p>Mr. Basu, Learned Counsel for the applicant, submits that an interim order may be passed so that the promotion already given to the juniors of the applicant will be subject to the decision of this original application. None appears on behalf of the state respondents in spite of service of notice as reflected from the Affidavit of service filed on behalf of the applicant. Since the order of promotion was issued on November 29, 2017, we cannot persuade ourselves to pass an interim order to the effect that the order of promotion will be subject to the decision of this application.
