	The applicant has prayed for direction upon the	
	respondents for payment of salary immediately before the period	
	of suspension and for payment of salary during the period of	
	suspension of the applicant and also for fixation of pay scale of	
	the applicant for the post of CDPO with effect from the date the	
	applicant took over charge of Acting CDPO.	
	The contention of the applicant is that she has been	
	working as acting CDPO in Darjeeling Pulbazar ICDS Project.	
	The applicant was placed under suspension and a departmental	
	enquiry was started against her by the disciplinary authority. On	
	conclusion of departmental enquiry, the punishment of "censure"

from April 2014 to December 28, 2015, but the said representation has not yet been considered by the authority concerned for disbursement of salary immediately before the period of suspension and also during the period of suspension, though she was reinstated in the service long back.

Learned Counsel representing the applicant has not pressed for hearing of prayer 'b' of the original application, by which the applicant prayed for fixation of pay scale of CDPO from the date of her joining in the said post as acting CDPO. None appears on behalf of the state respondents in spite of service of notice as reflected from the affidavit of service filed on behalf of the applicant.

On consideration of the materials on record, we are of the view that the respondent no. 6 should have passed an order as to how the period of suspension of the applicant will be dealt with when the applicant was reinstated in service by order dated December 23, 2015. Accordingly, we direct the respondent no. 6, Director of Social Welfare, Government of West Bengal to consider how the period of suspension of the applicant will be dealt with and what arrears of salary will be payable to the applicant immediate before the date of suspension by passing a reasoned order in accordance with the provisions of the Rules by which the applicant is governed within a period of 12 (twelve) weeks from the date of communication of the order and take
