Ray, Learned Advocate.</p> <p>Affidavit of service filed on behalf of the applicants today is kept on record.</p> <p>The applicants have prayed for direction upon the respondents to give them the remuneration in terms of Memorandum dated February 25, 2016 issued by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal.</p> <p>The contention of the applicants is that they have been working as daily rated casual employees in different units under Deputy Director of Textiles (Sericulture), Bankura. The further contention of the applicants is that they are entitled to get remuneration in term of Memorandum dated May 20, 2013 and Memorandum dated February 25, 2016 issued by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal, but they have been deprived of their legitimate dues in spite of giving several representations in this regard before the appropriate authority.</p>

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Having heard Learned Counsel representing both parties and on consideration of the fact that the representation submitted by the applicants have not been considered till date, we direct the respondent no. 2, Commissioner of Textiles and Sericulture, Directorate of Textiles (Sericulture), Government of West Bengal to consider the entitlement of 15 applicants to receive remuneration as daily rated casual employees in terms of Memorandum dated May 20, 2013 and Memorandum dated February 25, 2016 issued by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal within a period of 12 (twelve) weeks from the date of communication of the order and take necessary follow up action within a period of 4 (four) weeks thereafter.

With the above direction, the original application stands **disposed of.**
