Accordingly, the respondent no. 2, Director General and Inspector General of Correctional Services, West Bengal is directed to consider the entitlement of the applicant to get remuneration in terms of Memorandum No. 9008-F(P) dated September 16, 2011 and Memorandum No. 4011-F(P) dated May 20, 2013 and Memorandum No. 1107-F(P) dated February 25, 2016 issued by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal within a period of 12 (twelve) weeks
