	a. To direct the respondents to release the balance	
	retrial benefit i.e. GISS (Group Insurance),	
	Provident Fund amount of Rs.46,847/-, and	
	Gratuity Rs.5,80,608/- deducting Rs.25,628/-	
	towards outstanding interest of his House	
	Building Loan forthwith together with an interest	
	at the rate of 18% per annum from the date of his	
	retirement i.e. 01.01.2011 till date of realization.	
	b. To issue any other appropriate order or orders to	
	which your applicant is entitled to get.	
	The Counsel for the Applicant, during the course	
	of hearing, has fairly submitted that belatedly the	
	Applicant has received the entire PF amount along with	
	the appropriate interest. Therefore, he has no claim of	
	interest on delayed payment of PF amount. However,	
	the Applicant has received the gratuity amount after

	01.02.2018. Therefore, the Counsel for the Applicant	
	has prayed for interest on the delayed payment of	
	gratuity and GISS. Mr. S. Ghosh, Learned Advocate	
	appearing for Respondent Nos.1 and 4 has drawn our	
	attention to the order dated 16.01.2018 passed by the	
	Principal Secretary to the Government of West Bengal	
	and has tried to convince the Court about the reasons	
	for such delay. We have gone through the order dated	
	16.01.18 and on perusal of the same, it is noticed that	
	due to their internal difficulties / latches they could not	
	finalise the amount to be paid to the Applicant.	
	Therefore, in our considered view, the Applicant	
	is entitled to interest for such delay in payment of	
	retrial dues since he retired on 31st December 2010 and	
	as per service rules, the department should complete	
	the due settlement before the date of retirement and	
	make payment after deducting government dues, if any.	
	But, in the instant case, the respondent had withheld	
	the entire PF, Gratuity and GISS amount for non-	
	settlement of house building loan to the tune of	
	Rs.25,628/- out of total of Rs.6,62,882/- however with	
	regard to PF, the interest has already been paid to the	
	Applicant.	
	Therefore, we direct the Respondent Authorities	
	to make payment of interest @ 8% per annum from the	
	date of his retirement till the actual date of payment
