	In this application, Susama Chaudhuri and				
	Subhrangshu Chaudhuri, wife and son respectively of				
	Subir Ranjan Chaudhuri, have prayed for certain reliefs,				
	the relevant portion of which is as under:

	It appears Subir Ranjan Chaudhuri, an Ex-Sub-	
	Officer of Baishnabghata Patuli Fire Station, was placed	
	under suspension on 23 <sup>rd</sup> June, 2008 as he was under	
	Police custody during the period from 31st May, 2008 to	
	12 <sup>th</sup> June, 2008 in connection with Amherst Street P.S. /	
	D.D. / Case No.104 dated 20 <sup>th</sup> June, 2007 and, thereafter,	
	departmental proceeding was initiated against him on	
	17 <sup>th</sup> January, 2014 for alleged misconduct of gross	
	violation of Service Conduct Rules. Subir Ranjan	
	Chaudhuri retired on 31st March, 2015 and thereafter	
	expired on 5 <sup>th</sup> February, 2018. It appears from the	
	application that the order of suspension was withdrawn	
	on 29 <sup>th</sup> December, 2011 and after his death by order	
	dated 25 <sup>th</sup> January, 2019 the departmental proceedings	
	were dropped. It is submitted by Mr. Routh as	
	suspension was withdrawn during the life time of Subir	
	Ranjan Chaudhuri and as the departmental proceedings	
	have been dropped, appropriate order may be passed for	
	release of superannuation benefits of late Subir Ranjan	
	Chaudhuri after deducting the benefits already received.	
	Submission is that during his life time Subir Ranjan

Chaudhuri was allowed to withdraw provident fund of Rs.34,766/- and Group Insurance amounting to Rs.4,319/-. However, as till date gratuity, pension, arrear salary, leave encashment under career advancement scheme and family pension have not been released, appropriate order may be passed.

Mr. G.P. Banerjee, learned advocate for the State respondent submits on instruction from the authorities that as suspension order was withdrawn and thereafter, departmental proceedings have been dropped, the applicant is entitled to the superannuation benefits, minus the benefits which he has already been received, in accordance with the service Rules.

Mr. B. Mitra, the departmental representative of the respondent nos. 4, 5 and 7 adopts the submission of Mr. Banerjee.

Having heard the learned advocates for the parties, as admittedly the suspension order of Subir Ranjan Chaudhuri was withdrawn on 29<sup>th</sup> December, 2011 and after Subir Ranjan Chaudhuri expired, the departmental proceedings, by order dated 25<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 were dropped, as evident from page 108 of the application, we are of the view that the applicant is entitled to the reliefs as sought for and therefore, the application is disposed of by directing the Director General, West Bengal Fire and Emergency Services, Government of West Bengal, the respondent no.2 to pass
