On February 9, 2004, the Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Animal Resources Development passed an order in compliance with the direction given by the Hon'ble High Court in WPST No. 380 of 2002, wherefrom it appears that the applicants cannot be absorbed even on temporary basis in the Government employment. The applicants have also claimed that they have been given financial benefits in terms of Memorandum dated December 22, 2010 and Memorandum dated September 16, 2011 issued by the Finance Department, Government of West Bengal, but no document in this regard is enclosed with the original application. applicants have claimed financial benefits in terms of Memorandum dated February 25, 2016 issued by the Finance Department, Government of West Bengal.

Having heard Learned Counsel representing both parties and on consideration of the materials on record, we direct the respondent no. 1, Principal Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Animal Resources Development to consider and decide the entitlement of the applicants to get financial benefits in terms of Memorandum No. 1107-F (P) dated February 25, 2016 issued by the Finance Department, Audit Branch by passing a reasoned order within a period of 12 (twelve) weeks from the date of communication of the order and to intimate the result of the same to the applicants within a period of two (2) weeks thereafter.

With the above direction, the original application is **disposed of.**
