	The applicant has prayed for direction upon the	
	respondents for continuation of contractual service of	
	the applicant as Conductor of Bus run by West Bengal	
	Surface Transport Corporation Limited.	
	It appears from the materials on record that the	
	applicant was engaged as Conductor purely on	
	contractual basis initially for a period of 6 (six) months	
	on the terms and conditions enumerated in the order	
	dated November 6, 2009 issued by the Managing	
	Director, West Bengal Surface Transport Corporation	
	Limited. It further appears from the materials on	
	record that the contractual service of the applicant	
	continued upto October 31, 2012. The applicant used	
	to get daily wage @ Rs.150/- per day for performance of	
	duty allotted to him and in the absence of allotment of	
	duty on a particular day, the applicant was given	
	Rs.30/- only for non-performance of duty. The	
	grievance of the applicant is that he was not allowed to	
	continue in contractual service after October 31, 2012.	
	By referring to order dated August 26, 2009	
	passed by this Tribunal in OA-866 of 2007, Learned	
	Counsel for the applicant submits that this Tribunal	
	gave direction to the state respondents to consider the

case of the applicant for appointment under the existing rules applicable in the case, if the state respondents do not engage any agency for performance of duty for which the applicant was previously empanelled. The applicant got contractual appointment after the said order of the Tribunal but the contractual service was discontinued w.e.f. October 31, 2012. In our view, no right is accrued in favour of the applicant for continuation of contractual service. The applicant could not be appointed in the post of Planning Assistant-III due to engagement of private agency as reflected from the letter issued by the Commissioner of Transport Department in favour of Deputy Secretary of Finance Department, Government of West Bengal on November 30, 2015 and as such appointment on the basis of previous order of the Tribunal does not arise.

There is nothing on record to indicate that West Bengal Surface Transport Corporation Limited is brought within the jurisdiction of the Tribunal by issuing any Notification by the State Government under section 15 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 and as such the dispute between the applicant and the West Bengal Surface Transport Corporation Limited cannot be adjudicated by this Tribunal. In our view, the dispute between the applicant and the West Bengal Surface Transport Corporation Limited is clearly barred under section 15 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.
