	The applicant joined as Dental Surgeon at	
	Salboni Rural Hospital in the district of Paschim	
	Medinipur on March 2, 2009. Prior to joining the	
	service under Government of West Bengal, the	
	applicant claims to be employed as Short Service	
	Commissioned Officer in Army Dentral Corps under	
	Ministry of Defence, Government of India from March 9,	
	1997 to March 8, 2002 and was released from the said	
	service in the rank of Major. He also claims to be	
	employed in Ex-Servicemen Contributory Health	
	Scheme Polyclinic at Panagarh in the district of	
	Burdwan, West Bengal as Dental Officer under Ministry	
	of Defence, Government of India from April 1, 2005 to	
	May 31, 2007. The grievance of the applicant is that	
	his past service under Ministry of Defence, Government	
	of India has not been counted for retirement benefits of	
	the applicant.	
	Previously, the applicant moved the Tribunal by	
	filing OA-900 of 2016 which was disposed of on	
	January 2, 2017. This Tribunal gave direction to the	
	Principal Secretary to the Government of West Bengal,

Department of Health & Family Welfare to take a decision on the basis of representation submitted by the applicant and to communicate the said decision to the applicant forthwith. The Additional Chief Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Health & Family Welfare passed an order on February 15, 2017 whereby he asked the applicant to furnish relevant information for taking decision as directed by the Tribunal.

Mr. Ghosh, Learned Counsel for the applicant, contends that the applicant has already furnished information to respondent no. 1 on March 8, 2017 through proper channel, but no decision has yet been taken by the Principal Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Health & Family Welfare. The documents which are alleged to have been enclosed with the application submitted to respondent no. 1 on March 8, 2017, have not been placed before us on behalf of the applicant. Rule 194 of West Bengal Services (Death-cum-Retirement Benefit) Rules, 1971 as amended by Notification dated June 14, 1978 lays down that regular military service rendered by a person before appointment under Government of West Bengal may be counted when the service under the State Government is confirmed or has attained quasi permanent or permanent status. The conditions for counting of past service rendered under the Army before civil employment under the State Government are laid down in the said Rules. All documents have

not been placed before us for formation of opinion whether the applicant rendered regular military service before employment under the State Government. Accordingly, we have not decided on merit the issue of counting of past service of the applicant rendered in the Army for the purpose of retirement benefits.

Since the issue of counting of past service of the applicant has not been decided finally by the Principal Secretary to the Government of West Department of Health & Family Welfare due to not furnishing of relevant information by the applicant before February 15, 2017 and since the applicant claims to have submitted relevant information to respondent no. 1 through proper channel on March 8, 2017, we direct the respondent no. 1, Principal Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Health & Family Welfare to take final decision on the issue of counting of past service of the applicant after giving the applicant an opportunity of hearing within a period of 12 (twelve) weeks from the date of communication of the order communicate the result of the same to the applicant within a period of 2 (two) weeks thereafter.

With the above direction, the original application stands **disposed of.**
