Ray, Learned Advocate.</p> <p>The applicant has prayed for direction upon the respondents to issue appointment letter in favour of the applicant in Group-D post on compassionate ground.</p> <p>It appears from the materials on record that one Manik Chandra Barman died on December 16, 2012 when he was working as Tobacco Development Officer, ADA, Dinhata-II, under administrative control of the Deputy Director of Agriculture (Admn.), Government of West Bengal. The applicant being the son of the deceased employee submitted application for compassionate appointment for Group-C post on March 4, 2013. On March 12, 2015, the said prayer of the applicant for appointment in Group-C post was rejected and the order of rejection was communicated under memo dated March 12, 2015 by the Assistant Secretary, Department of Agriculture, Government of West Bengal. Subsequently, on April 20, 2017, the applicant submitted application for appointment in Group-D post before the respondent no. 2. The said application was processed and on June 5, 2017, the respondent no. 3 forwarded the case of the applicant to the respondent no. 1.</p>

Accordingly, we direct the respondent no. 1, Principal Secretary, Department of Agriculture, Government of West Bengal to consider the prayer of the applicant for compassionate appointment in Group-D post as communicated by the respondent no. 3 under Memo. No. 537/3E/IX/213/2010 (Pt.-I) dated June 5, 2017 in accordance with law and pass a reasoned order within a period of 12 (twelve) weeks from the date of communication of the order and to communicate the result of the same to the applicant within a period of 2 (two) weeks thereafter.

With the above direction, the original application stands disposed of.
