It is submitted by Mr. Gautam Pathak Banerjee, learned advocate for the alleged contemnor / respondent, that the directions contained in the order dated 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 passed in O.A. 585 of 2019: Sankar Banerjee vs. The State of West Bengal & Ors., have been complied with as the alleged contemnor no.2 by office order contained in the memo dated 2<sup>nd</sup> March, 2020, has intimated that sanction has been accorded towards reimbursement of LTC for a sum of Rs.48,951/- in favour of the applicant for his visit along with his two family members. It appears thereafter by memo dated 3<sup>rd</sup> February, 2021 the said alleged contemnor informed the applicant that though by memo dated 2<sup>nd</sup> March, 2020 he was informed that money had been sanctioned and the intimation was sent by registered post and was received by him, however till date as he is yet to provide the office concerned with his bank account details with necessary documents in which his reimbursement amount would be paid online through e-payment, the amount could not be disbursed. Request was made to provide as early as possible the bank account details with necessary documents and papers required for epayment.

Mr. Banerjee submits since pursuant to the directions contained in the order dated 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 passed in O.A. 585 of 2019, money has been sanctioned for reimbursement of LTC bill of the applicant, however, as the applicant has not provided the bank details it could not be paid through e-payment and as there has been compliance of the directions contained in the said order, no further order may be passed on the contempt application and the contempt
