On consent of the learned counsels for the contesting parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

Mrs. Agarwal, learned counsel for the Contemnor/OP files a copy of a reasoned order as the compliance report in terms of the Tribunal's direction in OA 876 of 2015 dated 10.02.2020. Let the copy be kept on record. Submission of Mrs. Agarwal is that since in terms of the Tribunal's direction, the alleged Contemnor/OP has complied by passing a reasoned order, the contempt proceedings may be dropped.

Since the Tribunal had directed the alleged Contemnor/OP to take "final decision with regard to the compassionate appointment", the Tribunal finds that by passing a reasoned order, the alleged Contemnor/OP has taken the final decision and communicated the same to the applicant.

In view of this, the Tribunal is satisfied that the direction of the Tribunal has been complied. The contempt proceedings are dropped and the contempt application is disposed of.
