Further, Mrs. Agarwal submits that so far the compliance of the order relating to payment of interest to the petitioner is concerned, a proposal in this regard has already been submitted before the Finance Department. She submits that as soon as it is cleared, the same will be paid to the applicant. In view of this development, Mrs. Agarwal prays for accommodation for compliance of the second part of the order to which Mr. Halder has no objection.

Mr. B. Mitra, the Departmental Representative of the Principal Accountant General (A&E), West Bengal submits that since the principal amount has already been paid, Mr. S.P. Raju, Senior Accounts Officer, Pension-XI of the Office of the Principal Accountant General (A&E), West Bengal has no further role relating to the payment of the interest. Therefore, he prays for relief from this contempt application.

In view of the above submission of Mr Mitra, let the name of Mr. S.P. Raju, Senior Accounts Officer, Pension-XI of the Office of the Principal Accountant General (A&E), West Bengal be expunged from the array of the alleged contemnors.
