The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11th February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

At the very outset, it is submitted by Mr. A. De, the departmental representative that the directions contained in the order dated 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 passed in OA 68 of 2021 (Disha Chakraborty (Bhattacharya) – versus- The State of West Bengal and others) have been complied with as a reasoned order has been passed on 16<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 holding that the claim of the applicant for compassionate appointment in the died-in-harness category is justified.

Heard Mr. M. Karim, learned advocate for the applicant.

The relevant portion of the order passed on 16<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 is as under :-

*“...Upon consideration of the facts hereinbefore mentioned, it is found that the Applicant’s claim for compassionate appointment in died-in-harness case is justified. She is eligible for compassionate appointment to a Group-‘C’ post of the Government of West Bengal, subject to fulfilment of other criteria required for such appointment.*

*Respondent no. 3 in O.A. No. 68 of 2021, i.e. the District Magistrate & Collector, South 24-Parganas is to complete the process of appointment on compassionate ground in respect of Smt. Disha Chakraborty (Bhattacharya)*
