The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11th February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

At the very outset, it is submitted by Mr. A. De, the departmental representative that the directions contained in the order dated 17th March, 2021 passed in OA 68 of 2021 (Disha Chakraborty (Bhattacharya) - versus- The State of West Bengal and others) have been complied with as a reasoned order has been passed on 16th June, 2022 holding that the claim of the applicant for compassionate appointment in the died-in-harness category is justified.

Heard Mr. M. Karim, learned advocate for the applicant.

The relevant portion of the order passed on 16th June, 2022 is as under:-

"....Upon consideration of the facts hereinbefore mentioned, it is found that the Applicant's claim for compassionate appointment in died-in-harness case is justified. She is eligible for compassionate appointment to a Group-'C' post of the Government of West Bengal, subject to fulfilment of other criteria required for such appointment.

Respondent no. 3 in O.A. No. 68 of 2021, i.e. the District Magistrate & Collector, South 24-Parganas is to complete the process of appointment on compassionate ground in respect of Smt. Disha Chakraborty (Bhattacharya)

Since the directions contained in the order dated 16th June, 2022 have been complied with, no further order is passed on the contempt application. The contempt proceedings are dropped.

The contempt application is disposed of.
