The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

Mrs. Mitra, learned counsel for the applicant files a copy of memo. no. 1077 dated 24.07.2025 issued by the Home & Hill Affairs Department and suggest that the respondent authorities has now fully complied with the direction of this Tribunal.

In terms of order dated 14.07.2023 in OA 388 of 2023, the Additional Chief Secretary, Home & Hill Affairs Department was directed to pass "a reasoned order after verifying the documents and records submitted by the applicant and considering the submissions of both the learned counsels as recorded in above paras within a period of 3 (three) months from the date of communication of this order." Mrs. Mitra submits that in compliance to the direction of this Tribunal, the Additional Chief Secretary, Home & Hill Affairs Department passed this reasoned order in favour of the applicant. Copy of such memo has already been served by the Department to the applicant.

The Tribunal after examination of this reasoned order is satisfied that the respondent authorities have fully complied with the direction of this Tribunal in OA 388 of 2023 and the applicant's side is well aware of such decision.

In view of the above facts, the contempt proceedings are **dropped** and the contempt application is **disposed of.**
