The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsels for the contesting parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

Mr. S. Ghosh, learned counsel for the State respondent files a document which appears to be a reasoned order passed by the Additional Chief Secretary in terms of the Tribunal's order dated 22.06.2022. The Tribunal had disposed of the OA-453 of 2018 by directing the applicant to file a representation before the respondent and Respondent was directed that if such a representation is filed, the same be considered and disposed of within a period of 12 (twelve) weeks from the date of communication of this order.

Accordingly, the applicant had submitted the representation and he was allowed to join. Mr. Ghosh submits that so far release of arrear salaries is concerned, the same is being processed and will be cleared in due course of time as per rule. Both the learned counsels agree that the respondent has complied with the Tribunal's order substantially, therefore, the contempt application may be dropped.

In view of the above compliance report and submission by the learned counsels, this contempt proceeding is **dropped** and the contempt application is **disposed of.**
