The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5 (6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

Liberty is given to the applicant's side to change the name of the alleged contemnor from Dr. Siddhartha Neogi to Dr. Swapan Soren. Mr. Pal, learned counsel for the applicant argues that the respondent authorities are yet to comply with the direction of this Tribunal dated 27.04.2022. By this order in OA-643 of 2018, the Director of Health Services was directed to take a decision and pass a reasoned order regarding regularisation of leave of the applicant and consequently process the pension and other retiral benefits. Mr. Pal also reads out a paper addressed by the Principal Accountant General (A &E) to Medical Superintendent-cum-Vice Principal, S.S.K.M. Hospital drawing his attention to comply the order of this Tribunal.

Mr. Banerjee appearing on behalf of the alleged contemnor submits that the process has begun for regularisation of leave and once completed and if other cirtarias are fulfilled, the pension proposal will be submitted before the Principal Accountant General. Mr. Banerjee also assures to update this Tribunal with more specific information on the next date.

The matter is admitted. Let the matter appear under the heading **Hearing on 18.02.2025**.
