The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the Notification No.949-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 24th December, 2020 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under sub-Section (6) of Section 5 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

It is submitted by Mr.G.P.Banerjee, learned advocate for the alleged contemnor on instruction that the directions contained in the order dated 20th January, 2020 passed in OA-995 of 2019 (Dr.Mayoukh Kumar Chakraborty Vs. The State of West Bengal & Others) have been substantially complied with, though belatedly, as evident from copies of the documents filed which are on record.

Mr.M.N.Roy, learned advocate appearing on behalf of the applicant submits that though written instructions have been issued and his client has received the General Provident Fund amount, other dues are yet to be disbursed. In future, if dues are not paid, the applicant may be granted liberty to move afresh.

Since it is an admitted position that the directions contained in the order dated 20th January, 2020, have been substantially complied with, no further order need be passed on the contempt application. The contempt proceedings are dropped. The contempt application is disposed of.
