The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5 (6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsels for the contesting parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

Mr.R.K.Jaiswal, learned counsel files a supplementary application in which a prayer is made for substituting the applicant, Jamini Mohan Chatterjee with his daughter, Sheila Chatterjee. Mentioned at para 2 of this application and submitted by the counsel that Jamini Mohan Chatterjee is deceased now. The name of Sheila Chatterjee being the unmarried daughter of the deceased, Jamini Mohan Chatterjee, is prayed for substitution as the legal heir.

The prayer is allowed. Let the name of Sheila Chatterjee be substituted in place of Jamini Mohan Chatterjee. Let the cause title and the title of the file be modified accordingly.

Mr.S.N.Ray, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent authorities files an "Update of the Case" and draws attention to paragraph 6. This Note signed by one, Siladitya Chakraborty, WBLS, Special Law Officer of the Department of Higher Education states that a proposal has been submitted to the Finance Department (Pension
