The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 536-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 26th August, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

The instant application has been filed being aggrieved with the non-compliance of the order dated 12.08.2021 whereby the OA was disposed of with liberty to the applicant to submit a comprehensive representation before the respondent No. 2, if so advised and respondent No. 2 was directed to consider the said representation, if filed by the applicant and communicate his decision by way of a reasoned and speaking order.

Subsequently, the Director of Co-operative Audit, West Bengal vide his Memo. dated 01.08.2022 had passed the reasoned order, which has been filed by the contemnor by way of a compliance report. However, the counsel for the applicant has submitted that his representation has not been properly considered.

Heard the parties and after perusing both the orders dated 12.08.2021 and 01.08.2022, I am satisfied with the substantial compliance of the order dated 12.08.2021. Therefore, the CCP-7 of 2022 is dropped and notices are discharged.

If, the applicant is still aggrieved, he may take appropriate steps, if so advised.
