The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 496-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

None appears for the applicant when the matter is taken up for hearing.

Mr. S.N. Ray, learned advocate for the alleged contemnor/ Opposite party submits on instruction that the issue regarding compassionate appointment of a married daughter has been settled by the judgement delivered by the High Court on 13<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 in C.A.N. 12495 of 2014 in F.M.A. 1277 of 2015, the State of West Bengal & Ors – vs- Purnima Das & Ors and with the dismissal of the SLP(C)Nos. 17638-17639/2018 with application for intervention application/ impleadment by the Supreme Court on 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2019. Thereafter the matters are now pending before the Labour Department, Government of West Bengal for orders.

I find that the contempt application has been filed for non compliance of the direction contained in the order dated 10<sup>th</sup> November, 2017 passed in OA 1313 of 2016 (Kamal Das & Anr – vs- State of West Bengal & Ors. It is surprising that though the issue regarding appointment of married daughter has been settled after the dismissal of the Special Leave petition on 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2019 by the Supreme Court, it is surprising that three years have since passed and the alleged contemnor has not taken any step for implementation of the order dated 10<sup>th</sup> November, 2017 passed by the Tribunal.
