The instant application has been filed being aggrieved with the non compliance of the order dated 20.02.2020 whereby the following direction was passed:-

"In view of our above observations, we direct the respondent no. 2, Principal Chief Conservator of Forest (Head of Forest Force), West Bengal to consider the representation submitted by the applicant before the Principal Accountant General (A & E), West Bengal on August 25, 2008 (Annexure-E to the original application) in terms of G.O. dated June 21, 1990 and G.O. dated March 12, 2001 issued by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal on verification of office record by passing a reason order within a period of 12 (twelve) weeks from the date of communication of the order and take necessary follow up action, if any, within a period of 8 (eight) weeks thereafter.

With the above direction, the original application is disposed of".

Today, the counsel for the contemnor has filed one reasoned order dated 19.02.2021 and has submitted that as per the direction of the Tribunal, they have already passed the reasoned order in favour of the applicant.

However, the counsel for the applicant has submitted that till date the said amount has not been paid to him though there is a specific
