The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11th February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of both the sides, matter has been taken up.

The counsel for the respondent today has placed one order dated 29.03.2022 and has submitted that the authority in compliance to the order dated 24.02.2021 had already dropped the Disciplinary Proceedings against the applicant. Therefore substantial compliance has been made in the CCPA the same may be dropped. The counsel for the applicant has also admitted the said fact. Accordingly, CCPA is dropped. Notices are discharged.

The counsel for the applicant has submitted that though the contemnors have withdrawn the Disciplinary Proceedings, however, with regard to suspension order, nothing has been observed in the said order.

I have gone through the order and satisfied that substantial compliance has been made. However, if the applicant is so aggrieved, he may file fresh application. Let the order be kept with the record.
